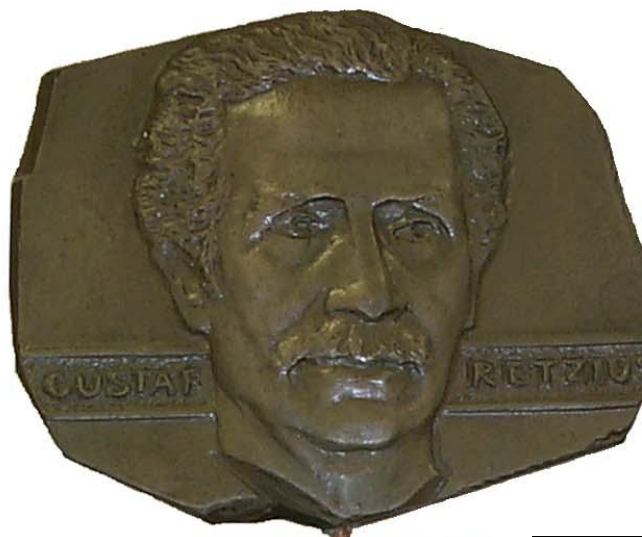

Noted Swedish anatomist and histologist at the Karolinska Institute, was one of the leaders in research during the classical period of neuroanatomy. "His comparative studies of a large series of subprimate, simian, and human brains, fetal and adult, clarified many of the more difficult problems of brain morphology" (Haymaker-Schiller, *Founders of Neurology*).
