

How to Apply

Applications for the 2017 camps will open on **Monday, Jan. 16, 2017**. Only current high school freshmen, sophomores and juniors are eligible to apply. Students will be chosen based upon their completed application, essay and letter of recommendation. If you have attended Camp CHLA before, you are not eligible to reapply.

Applications will close when 400 submissions have been received, or on Friday, Jan. 20, 2017—whichever comes first. **Only the first 400 applications submitted will be reviewed.**

All accepted applicants will be notified by **April 3, 2017**.

Participants are expected to attend all five days of Camp CHLA and take part in all activities. If your application is accepted, please be sure that your work, school or personal schedule will not conflict with attending camp.
