ATTENDING PEDIATRIC DENTIST sought by green Children's Hospital Los Angeles Medical Group in Los Angeles, CA.

Duties: Responsible for primary and comprehensive preventative and therapeutic oral health care for infants and children through adolescence, including those with special health care needs. Document patient diagnoses, care delivered and future treatment plans in patient electronic dental records. Offer anticipatory guidance, risk assessments and oral hygiene education, in addition to offering other preventative services. Conduct oral surgical procedures in connection with orofacial growth and development, and perform dental restorations, such as crowns and fillings. Provide dental patients behavior guidance and recommend behavior management techniques as deemed safe and appropriate for each patient, including protective stabilization, nitrous oxide analgesia and oral conscious sedation. Perform all other attending pediatric dentist duties.
