

## Employee Health Services Requirements

1. Written document of two measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) vaccinations in persons born after 1957, OR serologic (antibody titers) evidence of immunity to measles and rubella (German Measles).\*
2. Serologic evidence of immunity to chicken pox (varicella) or verbal knowledge of having the disease.\*
3. Written documentation and report of TB skin test (Mantoux) or T-Spot/ QuantiFERON®-TB Gold In-Tube test within the previous twelve months, OR in skin test positive persons, a written report of chest x-ray results.
4. Written documentation of COVID-19 vaccination. Have evidence of receiving either first dose of a one-dose vaccine regimen or second dose of a two-dose regimen.\*
5. Written documentation of one Tdap given as an adult\*
6. If working with blood, blood-borne products or human cell lines: written documentation of Hepatitis B vaccine series\*
7. During flu season (the months of October – April), written documentation of recent influenza vaccination.\*

\*If proof of immunization of cannot be obtained, you will have to sign a written declination form at the office Employee Health Services (EHS).
